Minimum Wage Increase:

- 42% for non-agricultural workers in the C area category - from Rs. 246/- to Rs. 350/-
- First time ever, simultaneous increase in the minimum wages for all

Bonus:

- For all eligible officials on revised norms for the years 2014- 15 and 2015-16

Minimum Pension:

- Enhanced to Rs. 1,000/- per month for perpetuity

Paid maternity leave:

- Enhanced from 12 weeks to 26 weeks

Unique Labour Identification Numbers:

- Given to more than 11 lakh establishments for easier compliance with labour norms
