### Signing of MoUs between NTPC and Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation Limited (GMDC)



**New Delhi, 26<sup>th</sup> February 2026:** NTPC Limited and GMDC have signed two MoUs to explore strategic collaboration in the utilisation of coal and lignite resources of GMDC. The first MoU focuses on establishing a partnership for utilisation of coal from GMDC's coal blocks for power generation at NTPC's existing and upcoming power stations. The second MoU aims to explore coal and lignite gasification and its downstream commercialisation, including pilot projects and syngas utilisation.

This partnership is expected to enhance India's energy security, promote clean coal technologies, and strengthen national energy self-reliance.

The signing ceremony took place in the esteemed presence of Shri. Gurdeep Singh, CMD NTPC & Shri. Roopwant Singh, IAS MD GMDC along with other Senior dignitaries from NTPC and GMDC.
