JBM Auto became the country's largest e-bus player in FY26 and aims to maintain this leadership, says Nishant Arya, its vice chairman and managing director. In an interview with Nitin Kumar, Arya outlines how JBM's integrated EV strategy, a robust order book of 10,000 e-buses, and a manufacturing capacity of 20,000 units will help the company retain its top position. He says JBM Auto is on track to meet its FY26 revenue guidance.

Government tenders, rapid electrification of routes, and schools adopting e-buses are boosting the sector. With over a dozen products for all route types, we are well poised to capitalise on these opportunities.

Which capabilities have given JBM the edge to emerge as the leader in the e-bus market?

You had guided for ₹6,000-6,500-crore revenue in FY26. Are you on track to achieve this?

Yes, we are on track to meet our FY26 revenue guidance.

What role is the EV business playing in your growth, and how do you see its contribution evolving?

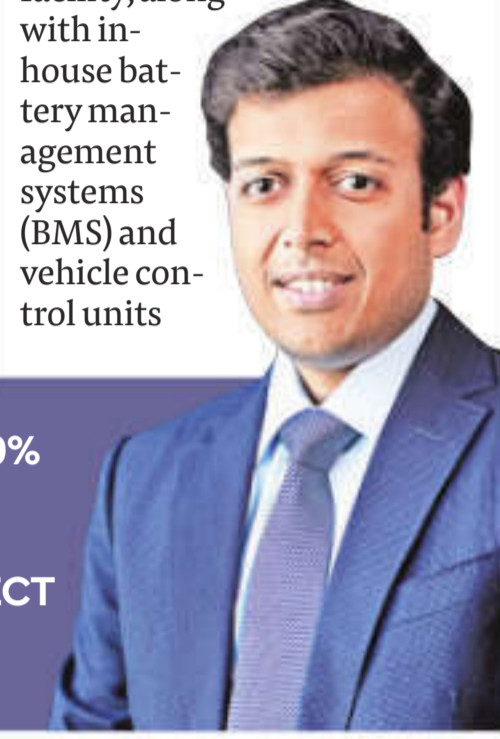
Currently, around 40% of JBM Auto's revenue comes from the EV business, and we expect this to rise to about 50% in the near term. The e-bus segment is gaining strong momentum and will continue to be a key growth driver as adoption accelerates in both domestic and international markets.

Lokal targets 50 mn active users in FY27

LOKAL, A NATIVE-language digital services platform focused on users in tier-2 and tier-3 India, plans to deepen its engagement to boost high-intent transactions per user.

The firm currently has 15 million active users across products and aims to scale this to 50 million in FY27 as it deepens penetration across under-served markets. "Our focus, however, remains on driving high-quality engagement and outcomes, rather than optimising purely for user numbers, Jani Pasha, co-founder and CEO, Lokal, told FE.

The company also plans to onboard more verified service providers to improve service quality. It will also continue to build monetisation through micro-transactions and subscription-led offerings aligned with spending behaviour in smaller towns. "AI-led personalisation, matching, and conversational discovery will play a key role in driving higher engagement, better conversion, and repeat usage across these categories," Pasha added.

The startup, which started out as a hyperlocal content and community platform in 2018, has evolved into a multi-app ecosystem helping native-language users access practical services such as jobs, agricultural advice, matrimony, learning content and expert consultations. Lokal today follows a "house-of-apps" approach, building focused products for specific user needs instead of bundling multiple services into a single super app. It now plans to expand into additional high-intent categories such as financial access, career advisory, skilling and local commerce, supported by shared infrastructure for trust, discovery and payments. AI-enabled assistants are also being developed to improve expert productivity, assist with user interactions, and enable more scalable, high-quality outcomes across services.

The company also aims to deepen penetration in under-served districts across India through its multi-language product strategy, while also selectively exploring international opportunities in markets with similar native-language internet user behaviour this year. "We are also a profitable firm and we expect to see strong progress on unit economics across key categories this year too," Pasha said.

Smartphones sector not affected by war: Oppo

SMARTPHONES SEGMENT IN India is seeing a positive outlook even though the ongoing West Asia crisis has affected several other sectors, an Oppo India executive said.

Goldee Patnaik, head of communication at Oppo India, said on Monday that the outlook looks promising at the moment and the war does not seem to be having an impact.

Quoting International Data Corporation (IDC) figures, he said the mid-premium seg-

ment grew 23% y-o-y last year, premium segment was up 37% and the super premium segment surged 7%. However, the entry-level segment saw a downward swing of 8%.

"It is part of the ecosystem. Also, mobiles have become part of life," he said, while answering

a question on whether the new models will be launched at increased prices due to various factors, including inflation and stock markets not performing well. He said the company is optimistic about the sales as there are lots of schemes like buybacks and cashbacks.

India's fiscal discipline provides headroom amid global volatility

West Asia conflict 'systemic tremor', moving from shocks to permanent volatility, says Sitharaman

STATING THAT the West Asia conflict has evolved from a "regional security concern" into a "systemic tremor", Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Monday said the current year is more challenging as the country moves from a "landscape of shocks" to one of "permanent volatility".

A dividend of a decade of fiscal discipline has enabled India to offer fiscal and monetary support to "lean against the wind" during economic downturn while many countries have no such room to manoeuvre as they deal with high debt and large deficits, she said.

"It is also important to note that a good public finance policy improves the counter-cyclical capacity of fiscal policy — especially the ability to "lean against the wind" in economic downturn. Today, many countries with high debt and large deficits have no room to ma-

noeuvre and they face a grim choice between austerity and instability"

"On the contrary, India has fiscal space — room to maintain our capex programme, room for the RBI to cut rates, room to offer targeted support to affected sectors. This is the dividend of a decade of fiscal prudence and discipline. This is the strategic value of fiscal prudence that pays dividends across decades. Therefore, we have been able to reduce the excise duty on diesel and petrol, specific exemptions were given on critical petrochemical products and SEZs (special economic zones) to operate in DTA (domestic tariff area)," she said. Speaking at the 'Golden Jubilee Celebrations' of the National Institute of Public Finance and Policy, the finance minister said India's debt profile stands out against other nations who face a constrained policy space after spending decades running expansionary fiscal policies.

India's general government debt-to-GDP ratio, which is debt

of both states and Centre, is the lowest among major economies after Germany at approximately 81%, she said. "More importantly, India is the only major economy where the IMF projects this ratio to fall significantly — to 75.8% by 2030 — while the debt outlook for the advanced economies such as the US, China, Germany, and others is projected to worsen," she said.

India's external debt-to-GDP ratio was 19.1% (as of September 2025), one of the lowest in the emerging market world, she added. India's foreign exchange reserves, at over \$688 billion, as of March 31, 2026, provide import cover for approximately 11 months, and that's "a substantial buffer to hold", she said.

Sitharaman said this is the result of "deliberate, sustained, and sometimes politically diffi-

cult choices" made over years of fiscal management. "For a rapidly progressing economy like ours, sound fiscal management is a policy imperative," she said.

Stating that public finance is not only about expenditure but also revenue mobilisation, the finance minister emphasised that a robust, fair, and efficient revenue system is essential for governance. "Revenue mobilisation is not just "tax rates"; it is also the administration of how the state reduces compliance friction for honest taxpayers while improving detection and deterrence for evasion," she said.

She said the tax administration system once relied on high rates, narrow bases, discretionary assessments, and adversarial enforcement, and it now rests on four pillars — simplification, technology, trust and

transparency. When asked about the need to expand the tax base and not rely on the same set of taxpayers for revenue generation, Sitharaman said it takes a lot of effort to broaden the base and "not so ideal route".

Giving the example of the earlier imposition of TDS for various transactions, she said the idea was to track high-value transactions and match with tax assessment data but it did not find favour. "...earlier stages of AI being used in CBDT did tell us that many such TDS payers are not even assesses. So, that was one route through which we wanted to be sure that we are touching transactions which will reveal if there are people doing that kind of a big time expenditure who are assesses and if they are not, as per the narrative goal, we are not going to harass them, we are not going to beat their doors, but we certainly would like to send them a mail to say — this is the TDS, the TDS is no new tax, but you can align it and reconcile it with the tax that you would pay and so on. But even TDS costs a lot of heartburn and people say: oh, tax terrorism, more tax from this government. No, if you're a taxpayer this is anyway going to be aligned," she said.

Why RBI is likely to keep rates steady and revise inflation, growth forecasts

AS THE Reserve Bank of India Governor Sanjay Malhotra prepares to announce the monetary policy on April 8, the economic backdrop has shifted dramatically since the February 2026 review: the West Asia conflict has clouded the economic horizon.

Rising crude oil prices and raging conflict now pose fresh challenges, with the potential to push up inflation and place corporate earnings and overall growth under strain due to rising input costs, supply disruption and shortage of raw materials in several sectors.

Given the uncertain economic situation, the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of the RBI is expected to keep interest rates unchanged for now, analysts say. It will likely take a cautious approach and wait for more data before making any big decisions. However, it may revise its outlook by lowering growth expectations and raising its inflation forecast due to ongoing price pressures and supply issues.

Hikes not imminent

Analysts and economists do not expect the MPC to hike the repo rate as retail inflation is still under control. A status quo on the policy rate will provide major relief to borrowers as their equated monthly instalments on home, vehicle, personal corporate and small business loans are unlikely to change. After the 25bps cut in December, the MPC unanimously decided to hold the repo rate — the key policy rate — unchanged at 5.25% in the February policy review.

"In the context of the stagflationary shock and exogenous nature of the event risk, we expect the RBI to keep rates on hold in April, while addressing specific pockets of strain. We expect a change in the policy stance towards tightness if there are material spillover

risks on core inflation and potential second round effects," said Radhika Rao, Senior Economist, DBS Bank.

"The RBI is likely to announce its full year growth and inflation forecasts keeping in view the impact of war on India. The RBI will remain vigilant and hold rates steady for the time being, without changing its stance from neutral," said Sonal Badhan, Economist, Bank of Baroda.

"We also believe this to be the end of the rate cut cycle. Further, if oil prices remain above US\$ 100 per barrel for a consistently long period of time and inflation breaches the upper tolerance band of RBI (6%), then there might be a chance of rate hike by the central bank towards the end of FY27."

Growth, inflation forecasts to be revised

Rao said the bank has revised upwards FY27 inflation forecast to 4.6% from previous 4.0%, with an upside risk of 50-60 basis points if crude stays north

of \$110 this quarter and next. Real GDP growth forecast has been trimmed to 6.5% from the previous forecast of 7.0% for FY27 as higher inflation will lift the nominal pace but impinge on the real growth rate. We foresee additional if the conflict prolongs or energy prices stay high.

A wider energy import bill and subdued demand for goods exports can widen the current account deficit to -1.8% of GDP against the baseline -1.3% of GDP, Rao said. Higher current account deficit combined with subdued capital flows outlook, pave the way for a third consecutive balance of payments deficit (in FY27 after FY25- FY26 deficits) — a first for the economy, DBS said. The rupee will be vulnerable to further near-term weakness against this backdrop.

Domestic inflation is coming off a low starting point base, with FY26 average at 2.0-2.2%, suggesting there is more cushion to absorb the risk of fuel price hikes in FY27, without posing material risk

to the upper bound of the target range at 6%. "With this shock being primarily supply-driven and likely transient, monetary policy might be a blunt and potentially ineffective tool in the short term to arrest inflationary expectations," Rao said.

If the ongoing energy shock persists for a few more weeks, the growth drag could begin to outweigh the inflation shock. The RBI lifted its FY26 GDP forecast to 7.4% from an earlier estimate of 7.3% in the February policy review. It also revised upward the projection for CPI inflation to 2.1% from 2%. **FULL REPORT ON**

Central bank revises banking correspondent classification

Mumbai: The RBI has proposed that in addition to bank branches, banking correspondents should be classified into two categories based on their assignments and suggested uniformity in fixing their wages.

In the draft norms on branch authorisation released on Monday, the RBI proposed defining three types of delivery points — bank branches, Business Correspondent-Banking Outlet and Business Correspondent-Banking Touchpoint.

Banking correspondents are assigned in remote areas to perform retail banking operations, expanding the reach of banks and helping in financial inclusion. Currently, there is no classification among business correspondents, while the commissions they get paid vary from bank to bank. As of June 2025, there were over 16 lakh business correspondents engaged by various lenders.

Meanwhile, the RBI said the limits for FPI investment in Government Securities (G-Secs), State Government Securities (SGSs) and corporate bonds will remain unchanged at 6%, 2% and 15% respectively, of the outstanding stocks of securities for FY27 for the general route. **ENS**

Gas supply raised to 90% of demand for fertiliser plants

New Delhi: Natural gas supplies to fertilizer plants have been raised to about 90% of their demand after oil firms procured LNG from spot market as part of measures to manage fuel availability amid disruptions due to the Strait of Hormuz situation, officials said.

Gas supply has been raised to 90% of their six-month average consumption using spot procurement, Sujata Sharma, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, said at a news briefing. While LNG supplies from Qatar are suspended, Indian firms are buying from alternate suppliers. PTI

SEBI eyes push to upskill independent directors, deepen corporate governance

THE SECURITIES AND Exchange Board of India (SEBI) is planning a joint initiative to build the capacity of independent directors and strengthen corporate governance through collaboration with regulators, industry, professional bodies and academic institutions, Chairman Tuhin Kanta Pandey said.

"SEBI will seek to embark on a joint initiative for capacity

building of independent directors at scale with a view to further improve corporate governance," he said at the CII corporate governance summit. Pandey's statement comes in the wake of recent boardroom tensions at HDFC Bank that led to the exit of its Chairman.

According to him, firms that perform, innovate and are technologically adept are of abiding interest to its investors. "Therefore, independent directors are not there only for compliance

and pointing fingers at management but also for supporting and finding solutions through accountability. They need to bear this responsibility in mind," he said. "It can certainly be encouraged, enabled and supported — through collaboration between regulators, industry bodies, professional bodies and academic/business institutions," the chairman said. "And this is where the next phase of evolution lies. If the first phase of governance reform was about

IOC, BPCL defer maintenance at few units to ensure fuel supply

IN A bid to ensure stable and adequate fuel supplies, public sector refiners Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) and Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd (BPCL) have postponed routine maintenance shutdowns — or turnarounds — at some of their refineries, a senior government official said on Monday.

India is the world's third-largest consumer of crude oil and the fourth-largest refiner, with a bulk of the petroleum fuels — such as petrol and diesel — and petroleum products consumed within the country, and some volumes exported.

The country has a refining capacity of roughly 260 million tonnes per annum (mtpa). IOC is India's largest refiner with 70.25 mtpa of refining capacity spread over nine refineries. BPCL has three refineries with a cumulative crude processing capacity of 35.3 mtpa.

Refineries take periodic planned maintenance shutdowns, or turnarounds, to ensure operational safety, comply with regulations, and replace equipment that needs to be changed. These scheduled refinery outages help with inspection, cleaning, repairs, and upgrades to maintain and even improve operational efficiency.

All Indian refineries are operating at peak capacity utilisation rates with some even operating at over 100% of their nameplate capacity, with adequate crude oil inventories, Petroleum Ministry Joint Secretary Sujata Sharma said. Sufficient petrol and diesel stocks are being maintained in the country, and there is no shortage of the two critical fuels, she added.

Sharma also said that some of the IOC and BPCL units that were scheduled to go under maintenance in the coming days will continue operating at optimum capacity, and the maintenance shutdowns have been deferred for the time being.

She did not provide details on these units and their planned maintenance shutdown plans. The move comes at a time when Indian refiners have stepped up domestic produc-

tion of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) to partly cover the shortfall in LPG imports, which have been hit hard due to the effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz amid the West Asia war. While the effective halt in vessel movements through the maritime movement have impacted India's crude oil and liquefied natural gas imports, the hit has been the hardest for LPG. Around 40% of India's oil imports and over 55-60% of LNG imports come from West Asia through the Strait; as for LPG, a whopping 90% of the country's imports depend on the narrow waterway between Iran and Oman.

Moreover, private sector refiner Nayara Energy is proceeding with a month-long turnaround at its 20-mtpa refinery in Gujarat from April 9-10. Nayara had already been deferring its planned shutdown for several months.

It was scheduled for last year, but had to be deferred after Nayara was slapped with EU sanctions due to its links with Russian oil major Rosneft, which is a major shareholder in Nayara. Nayara's refinery turnaround, which cannot be deferred further, is expected to tighten domestic LPG production to some extent, and the shortfall is likely to be covered by increasing LPG imports.
