Navy deploys INS Sahyadri for Malabar exercise

New Delhi, November 9

THE NAVIES of India, the US, Australia and Japan will kick-start the annual Malabar naval exercise in the Northern Pacific beginning Monday with an aim to further bolster interoperability among them.

The Indian Navy has deployed its guided missile frigate INS Sahyadri for the mega exercise being hosted by the US.

The exercise is taking place in Northern Pacific's Guam amid some strain in ties between India and the US over Washington's policies on trade and tariff. INS Sahyadri is at Guam for participation in the multilateral exercise Malabar, the Navy said. The exercise begins Monday.

"The participation of INS Sahyadri in exercise Malabar reaffirms India's enduring partnership and its commitment to strengthening coordination and enhancing interoperability..." the Indian Navy said.

Bhagwat: Can't put all Muslims in bracket, have to see good & bad

RSS SANSANGHCHALAK Mohan Bhagwat said on Sunday that majority of Muslims in the country did not approve of 'love jihad' or Ghazwa-e-Hind (an alleged holy war against India), but there was also a sizeable section of 'kattarpantis' (fundamentalists) in the community. "Good people, we have to segregate from the mob of bad people," he said in Bengaluru while responding to questions during the 'New Horizons' lecture session held to mark the centenary year of the RSS.

"...the 'sanskar' in our households, the 'maryada' of behaviour... Giving them to our children is our responsibility. We have faltered and the result is (the) success of 'love jihad'. Secondly, don't put everybody into (a) single bracket," he said, adding that there is a section among Muslims that deplores the perpetrators of Ghazwa-e-

Hind and 'love jihad'. "We should know them. We should keep them in contact," Bhagwat said. The RSS chief said even as there is a 'sizeable section of fundamentalists', we put the entire Muslim community in one bracket whenever instances of 'love jihad' or other such happenings surface. "That

is not good. We are Hindus, we don't think like that," he said, adding that the number of fundamentalists increases if the entire community is blamed. "Samaneeti' (policy of conciliation) is required. We have to fortify ourselves, so, 'dand neeti' (policy of punishment) is also required... Good people,

we have to segregate from the mob of bad people... There should be a distinction between the good and the bad. They should be separated. We can't treat everyone equally. Treatment should be different for different people. We should do this," he told the gathering.

He brushed aside the recent controversy over RSS registration in Karnataka. This is not the first time the question is raised, he said, asking whether anyone expected it to register with the British government in 1925. "After Independence, the laws did not make registration compulsory. We are categorised as (a) body of individuals. We are (a) recognised organisation," he said.

Recalling a court judgement after the Income Tax Department asked RSS to pay taxes, he said that the court recognised it as "a body of individuals and our 'guru dakshina' was exempted from the income tax. We were banned thrice. Each

time courts dismissed the ban and recognised RSS as a legal organisation," Bhagwat said.

On Karnataka Minister Priyank Kharge's recent pitch for regulating RSS activities in the state, Bhagwat said: "We need not answer them. We have other important work to do... The criticism makes us more famous. We have just witnessed (it) here in Karnataka. We will encourage them to raise more questions."

On whether the RSS would hold outreach programmes for minorities, he said, "No Brahmin is allowed in Sangh. No other caste is allowed in Sangh. No Muslim is allowed... No Christian... No Shaiva... Only Hindu is allowed. People with different denominations, Muslims... Christians can come to Sangh... Your speciality is welcome. But, when you come inside 'Shakha', you come as the son of 'Bharat Mata'... a member of the broader Hindu society," he said.

CJI says legal aid not act of charity, but moral duty

CHIEF JUSTICE of India B R Gavai Sunday said that "legal aid is not merely an act of charity but moral duty" and "an exercise in governance, in ensuring that the rule of law extends to every corner of our country".

At the Valedictory Function of the National Conference on 'Strengthening Legal Aid Delivery Mechanisms', organised by National Legal Services Authority (NALSA), the CJI said that the "legal aid movement stands as one of the finest expressions of our Constitution's soul, as a bridge between the letter of law and the lived realities."

NALSA Executive Chairman and CJI-designate Justice Surya Kant, addressing the event, said, "the notion of 'access to justice' is not an abstract ideal but rather a sapient right that must be continuously nurtured through institutional strength, professional competence, and compassionate engagement."

Justice Kant said NALSA has evolved "from a statutory body into a symbol of constitutional empathy".

The CJI said that "Legal Services Authorities should actively collaborate with academic institutions, research organisations, and professional bodies to conduct periodic social audits of our schemes and interventions" as "such partnerships can help... assess not only how many people we have reached, but how deeply and meaningfully our interventions have improved their lives".

Underlining the need for a long-term shared institutional vision while conceiving and executing legal services author-

ities, CJI Gavai said that "at present, much of our planning is often shaped by the tenure and priorities of individual Executive Chairpersons, each of whom may have only a limited period to conceptualise and implement initiatives". He added that "while this brings diversity of ideas, it also makes continuity and sustained implementation a challenge".

To address this, the CJI suggested "creation of an Advisory Committee at NALSA and SLAs (State Legal Services Authorities) respectively, comprising the current Executive Chairpersons and two or three future or incoming Executive Chairpersons. This committee could meet quarterly or every six months to discuss and oversee projects with a long-term perspective".

"Such an arrangement", he said, "would help institutionalise vision-based planning and ensure that key programmes, whether related to access to justice, awareness, or digital transformation, are carried forward consistently, regardless of administrative changes."

The CJI pointed out that while "judicial training often teaches" judges "to maintain a certain distance, to weigh evidence dispassionately, and to apply reasoned judgment, the work of legal aid demands the opposite sensibilities: empathy, collaboration, and ability to see beyond procedure into the conditions that produce injustice".

Recalling his visit to Manipur, where ethnic clashes erupted in May 2023, as Executive Chairman of NALSA along with some colleagues, CJI Gavai said, "We went to both the refugee camps of Meiteis and Kukis, and we are happy to see a smile on their faces."

Students sing RSS song at Vande Bharat flag-off, Kerala orders probe

KERALA EDUCATION Minister and CPI(M) leader V Sivan-kutty on Sunday ordered a probe after a controversy erupted over school students singing the RSS 'Gana Geetham' during the inaugural run of the Ernakulam-Bengaluru Vande Bharat Express on Saturday.

Twenty students and two teachers from the Saraswathi Vidyanikethan Public School in Kochi were among those who joined the inaugural run of the train, which was virtually flagged off by PM Narendra Modi.

The choice of song created a political storm in Kerala, with the ruling CPI(M) and Opposition Congress accusing the BJP of fusing the Railways to push its "divisive" politics.

Announcing the probe, Sivankutty said in his social media handle that the students being made to sing Gana Geetham is a serious matter. The Director of General of Education was told to submit a detailed report. "Using the students for the communal agenda of a political

organisation is flagrant violation of constitutional principles and is highly objectionable. There would not be any compromise on ensuring secular education of our children," the minister said.

Later in the day, he told reporters in Delhi that no school would be allowed to have proceedings that pose a challenge to secularism. "The state government gives an NOC (no-objection certificate) for starting a school. There are certain conditions for granting an NOC. If those conditions are found to have been violated, the state government has the power to withdraw the NOC," he said.

The CBSE-affiliated school comes under Bharatheeya Vidyanikethan, the Kerala chapter of Vidya Bharathi, an education wing of the RSS. School principal KP Dinto had said the Railways had no role in students singing the song, although the government entity shared the video in its social media handles.

On Sunday, CPI(M) State Secretariat alleged in a statement that the Railways' action was against the Constitution.

Energy cooperation foundation of India-Angola trade ties, says President

PRESIDENT DROUPADI Murmu, during her maiden visit to Angola as the Indian head of state, has said that energy cooperation is the foundation of trade ties between the two countries.

"Our economic partnership is based on a vibrant energy partnership. We agreed to further diversify trade and investment relations in new areas, including technology, agriculture, health, defence, infrastructure, and people-to-people ties," she said in a statement.

Murmu held bilateral talks with her Angolan counterpart João Lourenço in Luanda. Earlier, she was accorded a grand ceremonial welcome and Guard of Honour at the Presidential Palace in Luanda upon arrival. The two leaders held comprehensive talks aimed at deepening the multifaceted partnership between India and Angola.

During the discussions, President Murmu emphasised the importance of expanding cooperation across a wide range of sectors that reflect both nations' shared priorities and complementarities. She highlighted potential collaboration in areas such as sharing of parliamentary best practices, agriculture—especially in seeds and fertilizers—oil exploration and refining, connectivity and transport infrastructure, rare earth minerals, and diamond processing.

The President underscored India's specific expertise in several of these domains and conveyed India's readiness to work closely with Angola in harnessing these opportunities for mutual growth and prosperity. She also placed a strong focus on capacity building and training, digital public infrastructure, defence cooperation, and reforms of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC).

Lauding Angola's commitment to sustainable development, President Murmu congratulated the country for joining two major global initiatives led by India — the Global Biofuels Alliance and the International Big Cat Alliance — underscoring Angola's proactive role in addressing global environmental and biodiversity challenges. The two sides are scheduled to sign and exchange several Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) to formalise cooperation in identified sectors.

India and Angola also signed three MoUs in the field of defence, culture and Ayurveda. Two MoUs were signed to enhance cooperation in the areas of fisheries, aquaculture, marine resources, and consular matters. It was also decided to take forward the Air Services Agreement.

Murmu is on a four-day state visit to Angola, the first by an Indian President. The President's trip comes at a time when Angola is celebrating its 50th Independence Day anniversary (November 11), which she will attend, and both countries are observing 40 years of the establishment of their diplomatic ties in 2025. India is among the top three trading partners of Angola for some years, and currently it is second after China, sharing about 10% of Angola's external trade, as per official statistics reported by the MEA.

Woman, daughter critical after 'suicide' bid over SIR in Bengal

A 27-YEAR-OLD woman in West Bengal's Hooghly district allegedly attempted suicide along with her minor daughter reportedly out of fear after not receiving a Special Intensive Revision (SIR) enumeration form, her family claimed on Sunday.

The alleged incident took place at the woman's home at Dhaniakhali on Saturday.

The woman and her daughter are in SSKM Hospital's ICU, police said, adding that an investigation into the alleged incident is underway.

According to the woman's father, she was deeply distressed after she did not receive the SIR form while other family members did.

"She was frightened because she had no documents and feared being deported. Out of panic, she consumed poison along with her daughter," he said after visiting her daughter in Kolkata. She had been living at her parental home in Dhaniakhali in the district for the past six years following a marital dispute. She had been under visible mental stress for the past few days, they said.

Dhaniakhali TMC MLA Asima Patra accused the BJP of creating fear among people through misleading statements about NRC and detention camps. "When BJP leaders talk about sending people to detention camps, it spreads panic across Bengal. A similar case occurred in Dankuni a few days
