
Goals and objectives




Action Plan and future Strategy


Towards decarbonization, we are retiring old & inefficient thermal power plants and only installing thermal power plants which are in pipeline with better efficiency and lower carbon intensity. We will be installing 60 GW of renewables by 2032. We are working on multiple carbon capture and utilization (CCU) technologies such as green methanol to ensure clean transition with thermal generations serving as balancing load till affordable and reliable energy storage solutions are made available. We are also creating carbon sinks though our massive afforestation program. We are also making disclosures as per recommendations of the Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosure (TCFD) and CDP. We are exploring ways for carbon finance to generate funds for decarbonization and in the process of implementation of the Internal carbon pricing.


For controlling other air emissions such as SO2, NOx and SPM emissions, we ensure timely implementation of FGD, combustion modifications at concerned stations for NOx control and R&M of ESPs of older units for SPM control.














Goals and objectives




Action plan and future Strategy






Action Plan and Future Strategy

We're continuing to put health and safety at the heart of everything we do. To achieve this ambitious target, IT interventions such as a Suraksha safety app, use of intranet/ internet for incidence capturing, implementation of safety guidelines, standards and circulation of training materials are employed. NTPC has made a safety policy commitment to comply with applicable legal and other safety and occupational health requirements related to its activities. We have strengthened our contractor safety programs through Contractor safety assessment, Contractor risk control, Worker role competence and financial Penalty/Reward system.

Our NTPC hospitals provide round the clock service to our employees and their dependents across all locations. We also have empanelled 250+ speciality and super specialty hospitals across approx. 25 cities/towns for providing specialist treatment to our employees.










Goals and Objectives

We are committed to environmentally friendly, socially responsible, and techno-commercially viable handling and disposal of all waste generated in our premises. For ash utilization, various initiatives like long term supply agreements with high volume off takers, R&D for developing fly ash-based building materials and mine void filling etc. are employed. Integrated waste management systems are being implemented for complete waste reduction, collection, composting, recycling, and disposal system to protect human health and the natural environment. Our circular economy initiatives include biomass collection from the farmers and co-firing with coal for power generation.








Community Development





To make our supply chain sustainable, we are assessing our suppliers on Environment, Social & Compliance (ESC) evaluation criteria developed on various parameters such as safety, emission, water, statutory licenses, etc. Based on the result of assessment we are providing trainings to the vulnerable suppliers.

Progress in FY 2021

NTPC has steadily been making progress and has successfully audited 30 vulnerable suppliers for ESG in FY 2021 compared to none in FY 2020. The target for 2022 for the number of beneficiaries through Capacity building programs has already been achieved in FY 2021 with 104 beneficiaries.
